

CFA Uniforms

Boys & Girls Tops

- *3 button Polo shirts in Navy Blue, Primary Red, or White
- *Short or long sleeve
- *Cardigan or Crew-neck Sweater—Solid color. No fleece.
- *No rugby's. No long sleeve tee shirts under short sleeve polos. No colored tee shirts under short sleeve polos. No flannel shirts, tee shirts, imprinted shirts, or sweatshirts, etc.

Boys bottoms

- *Khaki (tan), black or navy blue casual dress pants (like Dockers)
- *No jeans, colored jeans, zip off at leg pants, cargo pants, carpenter pants, capris or shorts.

Girls bottoms (I know this is not easy to find)

- *Solid colored (khaki, black or navy blue) skirt that is below the knee in length and not a high slit
- *No short skirts, skorts, shorts, or pants, capris or denim

All clothes for the boys and girls should be **modest, conservative, and neat**. K-3rd graders should wear the uniform tops but jeans for pants, as they do not change clothes for gym. If you have any additional thoughts or questions, please call Mike @ 262-0222 or call Angie Quant @ 384-4825.
